Council Update

The city council has been addressing the dog ordinance that bans certain breeds of dogs. Those breeds are Pitbulls, and all mixed breeds of pit bulls, Rottweilers and Doberman Pinschers. The issue came about when a certain banned breed was allegedly misrepresented to the city hall with a different breed listed on the rabies certificate that was later found to be a banned breed.

The city would omit the breed specific ban and replace it with a dangerous/vicious animal section instead. This would allow our deputies to enforce the ordinance with precise rules and put more responsibility on the dog owner. Minot has changed their ordinance to replace the breed ban with the dangerous/vicious animal. Our city attorney has suggested that we change ours as well. All building permits are due into the city office by the 21st of the month if you want it to be approved at the next council meeting. All building permits are now \$20.00 which is due at the time of application. Permits are needed for sheds, fences, garages and all new construction. Tree planting also needs to be approved.
