CAT REGISTRATION

The City is enforcing the animal ordinance by requesting that cat owners register their cats with the City and show proof of rabies vaccination. There is no fee for this. This will help identify our domesticated cats when and if we live trap for strays. If you do not register your cat it may be picked up and taken to the Souris Valley Humane Society and you will be responsible for the fee to get it out. By Ordinance, cats are also to be leashed when off the owners property or unattended. No more than **four pets** per household are allowed.

It is also the policy of the RC Sheriff's Dept. and the city that if a stray dog or cat is picked up and fed and watered by a person, it is no longer considered a stray and the person having picked it up is responsible for it. If you notice a dog or cat within the City running at large, please contact City Hall at 362-7544. We will not take animals found outside of City limits.
