## RECREATIONAL FIRES

Recreational fires are allowed in covered containers equipped with screens and spark arrestors, weather permitting. Please make sure there is **no burn ban or red flag warning** before going online to ND burn ban maps **see our website under Featured news.**

Containers shall NOT be placed within 15 feet of structures or combustible material.

## Ordinance Changes

The council has changed the Animal and Fowl ordinance Chapter Eleven. You can find the updated version on the website, address provided on the upper right corner of this page. This takes effect after the second reading after the June 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting.

Other changes include: The increase of the connection fee to two hundred dollars (\$200.00) when new occupants move in. The late fee for not licensing dogs by March 1<sup>st</sup>, will go up to one hundred dollars (\$100.00) These increases take place on June 1<sup>st</sup>.

## CLEAN UP TIME

We are asking that residents please clean up their yards and remove any old un-running, non-licensed vehicles from their yards. They are becoming an eyesore for your neighbors and the community. Any other equipment, such as lawn mowers, BBQ grills, bicycles and appliances that do not run (refrigerators, stoves, water heaters) can be taken out to Earth Recycling located NE of Glenburn. Grass must be mowed on a regular basis, anything taller than eight inches must be cut down or trimmed.
